



Conditions and features of the Applied Science Research Center at the Applied Science Private University Issued by the Council of Deans in its meeting No. (24) Resolution No. (213/24) dated 17/8/2022

First: Determining the conditions of membership:

When selecting the members of the Center, the following shall be taken into account:

1. Number of published researches for the last 3 years.
2. Researcher impact factor. (H-index)
3. The scientific degree and academic rank of the researcher.
4. Not to be a faculty member and/or a member of the faculty of researchers in Jordanian universities.

Second: Membership Features:

Those who become members of the Center shall benefit from the following:

1. Use the university library during working hours.
2. The possibility of research cooperation with the university's faculty members.
3. Participation and attendance in all scientific activities held by the Center.
4. Benefit from the Center's financial rewards allocated to scientific research.

Third: Announcement of affiliation to the Center:

The Director of the Center is tasked with making the affiliation form, announcing the start of receiving applications, and then submitting these applications to the Board to determine the members.

Fourth: Determining the value of rewards:

Research Center members are paid amount of money for each research published by them in the Scopus database, and this amount includes publishing expenses.

These bonuses are paid to the Associate Members in the event that they publish research in the name of the Center by affiliation:

provided that the research is within the research priorities specified by the Council and is paid to the researcher when the research is listed in the Scopus database.

Fifth: Determining the date of commencement of the work of the Center:

- The disbursement of bonuses allocated to member research begins at the beginning of the 2022/2023 fiscal year.
